



WG Security Products Inc Wins appeal in Patent Case

WASHINGTON – WG Security Products, a designer and manufacturer of Electronic Article Surveillance (EAS) products, has won an appeal case against EAS giant Sensormatic, a division of Tyco, in the 5th U.S. District Court of Appeals.

The appeal was brought forth by Sensormatic, disputing an earlier ruling in the patent case which was viewed as an upset by many in the EAS industry.

The original suit, which was filed in April of 2004, charged WG Security Products with infringing on Sensormatic patents, namely the technology found in WG's Supersensor tag and other WG EAS tags and detection systems.

Sensormatic sought to prohibit WG from selling these products and requested damages for sales that Sensormatic claimed to have lost due to the claimed infringements. In July 2006, a jury unanimously rejected all of Sensormatic's claims and determined that tag's design and technology did not infringe on Sensormatic patents.

On November 8, the 5th District Court of Appeals in Washington DC upheld the original verdict.

Graham Handyside, VP of Global Operations for WG Security Products said "We spent a great deal of time and money defending a patent suit which had no basis. We are pleased that the Court of Appeals upheld the verdict. We continue to provide the quality EAS products and high level of service which our world-wide customer base expects from WG."
